

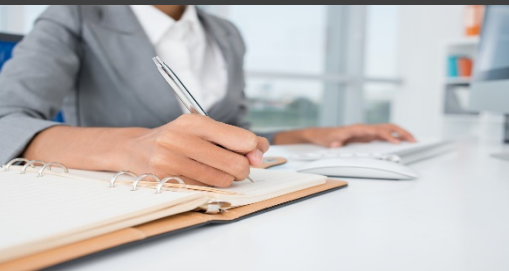

## Establishing the ERM Framework

- Develop an ERM policy aligned with frameworks such as COSO and ISO 31000.
- Document and track risks in a risk register, following guidance from frameworks like COSO and ISO 31000.
- Strategize to manage risks, including avoidance, mitigation, transfer, or acceptance, as outlined in COSO and ISO 31000.

## Stakeholder Analysis and Communication in ERM

- Identify key internal and external stakeholders, such as employees, management, investors, regulators, and customers.
- Assess their influence, interests, and impact on ERM outcomes.
- Develop and implement a communication plan to keep stakeholders informed about ERM activities and decisions.
